If a proposed project has a project website, development details or public meeting to share with community, send the following information to Sarah Stubblefield (neighborhoods@arlingtontx.gov):

- Images/documents you wish to share
- 2-3 sentences about the project/meeting
- Contact information for residents to call/email

OSI Neighborhood Engagement Team will share on Nextdoor, and coordinate any comments and final metrics to project team upon request.
