Each construction project is unique; therefore, not all of these typical inspections are required. Inspections that are Required to Pass, must be passed to move forward to the next Phase. Phase 3:	Inpsections include: Wind Bracing, Fire Rated Construction	Wind Bracing, Fire Rated Construction
