Kevin Kolbye serves as an Assistant Police Chief over the Support Operations Bureau in Arlington, Texas. Support Operations includes investigative units such as homicide, narcotics, traffic units and other specialized sections. He had previously presided over patrol operations after joining Arlington in 2015. Kevin began his law enforcement career in 1983 with the Dallas Police Department. He joined the FBI in 1987 and was promoted to Assistant Special Agent in Charge at the Dallas Field Office in 2007. He led the FBI's Swat Team, served in covert capacities and oversaw the Criminal and National Security Branch.

In 2009, the Assistant Director appointed Kevin for temporary assignment to serve as the On-Scene Commander in Afghanistan for all investigation and intelligence operations during Operation Enduring Freedom. In 2013, Kevin was selected by the Deputy Director as the Commander in Libya for the Benghazi investigation.

Kevin attended Texas Tech University and graduated with a BBA in Accounting. He received his Masters in Criminal Justice from Tarleton State University. He has also attended the FBI's Executive Development Institute, the Northwestern University Kellogg School of Management - Navigating Strategic Change, the Senior Management Institute for Police (SMIP) at Boston University. He is a 2019 graduate of the FBI National Executive Institute.
