WHEREAS, real progress has been made toward acceptance and equality, more work is needed to combat discrimination and prejudice; and

where we will be the month of June is designated as Pride Month to commemorate the Stonewall Riots which occurred 52 years ago and is recognized as the catalyst for the movement that has brought so much positive change in the last decade; and

WHEREAS, Arlington is committed to protecting the civil rights of lesbian, gay, bisexual and transgender communities to strengthen our city and to create a solid, unified society where hatred and inequality of any group is unacceptable.
