

WHEREAS, Judge Sim William Goodall, who has given a lifetime of service, was born on February 15, 1932; and

WHEREAS, Judge Goodall served in the US Air Force from 1953-1980, retiring with the rank of Colonel, and, during that time, received a law degree from Baylor University in 1958; and

WHEREAS, Judge Goodall was elected County Attorney for Hall County, Texas in 1960; served as Assistant District Attorney for the 100th Judicial District in Childress, Texas from 1984-1993; served as law partner at Williams, McCoy & Goodall from 1985-1993; and

WHEREAS, Judge Goodall served as an educator at various colleges across Texas from 1962 until 1992 and then as Police Legal Advisor for Odessa, Texas from 1993 until 1996; and

WHEREAS, Judge Goodall has served the City of Arlington (full-time and part-time) as the Police Legal Advisor from 1996 until 2004 and then Associate Municipal Court Judge from 2006 until now; and

WHEREAS, Judge Goodall, who has donated almost 24 gallons of blood over the past 25 years, received the Presidential Volunteerism Award in 2018 for service, including approximately 20 years at the National Cemetery in Grand Prairie; and

WHEREAS, after 23 years of service to the City of Arlington, Judge Goodall will be retiring on September 30, 2021.
