Presentation

Mr. Randolph, Deputy City Manager presented information requested at the previous meeting including information on the Unity Council Implementation Plan, 2014 and 2018 Bond Project Lists, and a modified Thoroughfare Development Plan map that shows the remaining capacity to achieve build-out.

Mr. Orloski, Director of Parks and Recreation presented a history and overview of the department.

Mr. Orloski then presented 13 proposed park projects categorized as trail development, park development, or recreational facility, totaling \$47,410,238.
