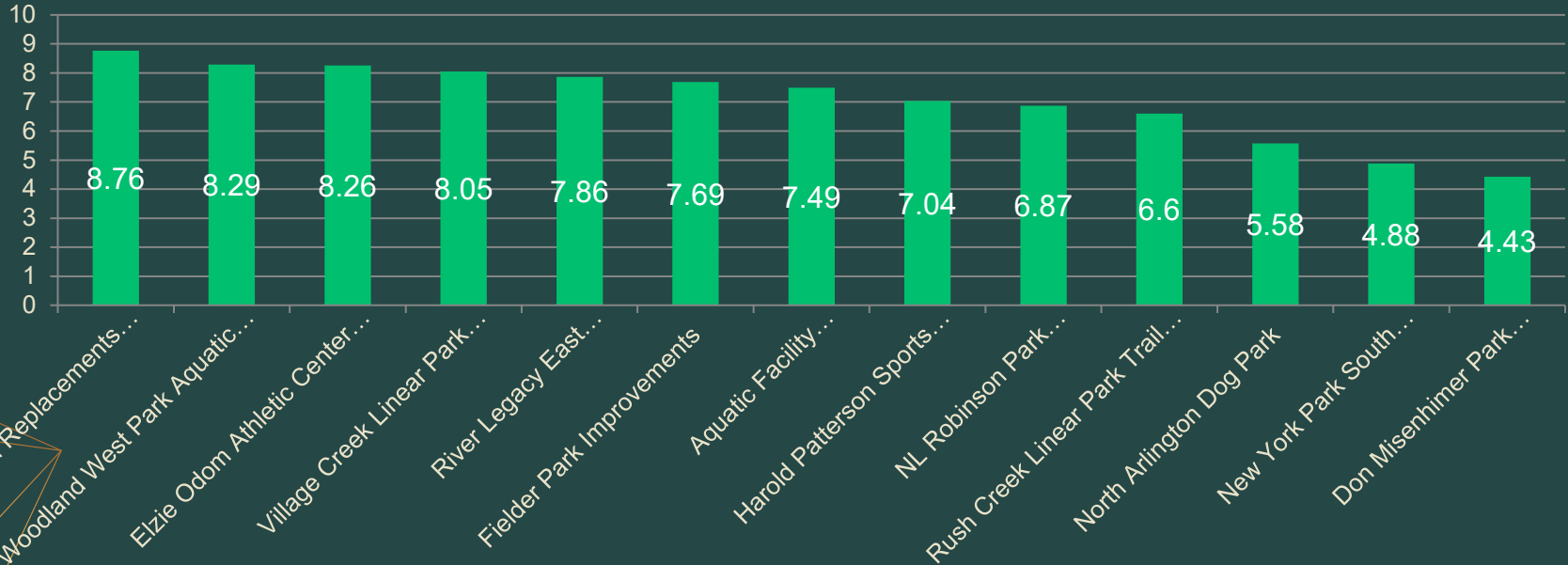

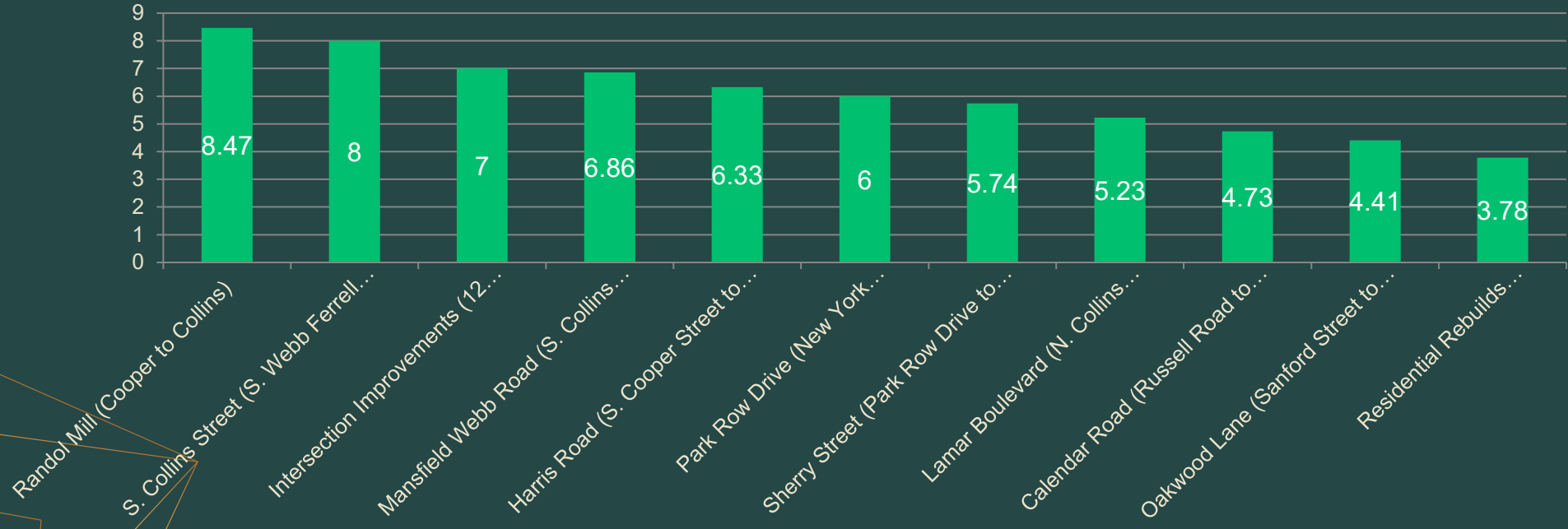

## Rank the Proposed Park Projects from Highest to Lowest Priority



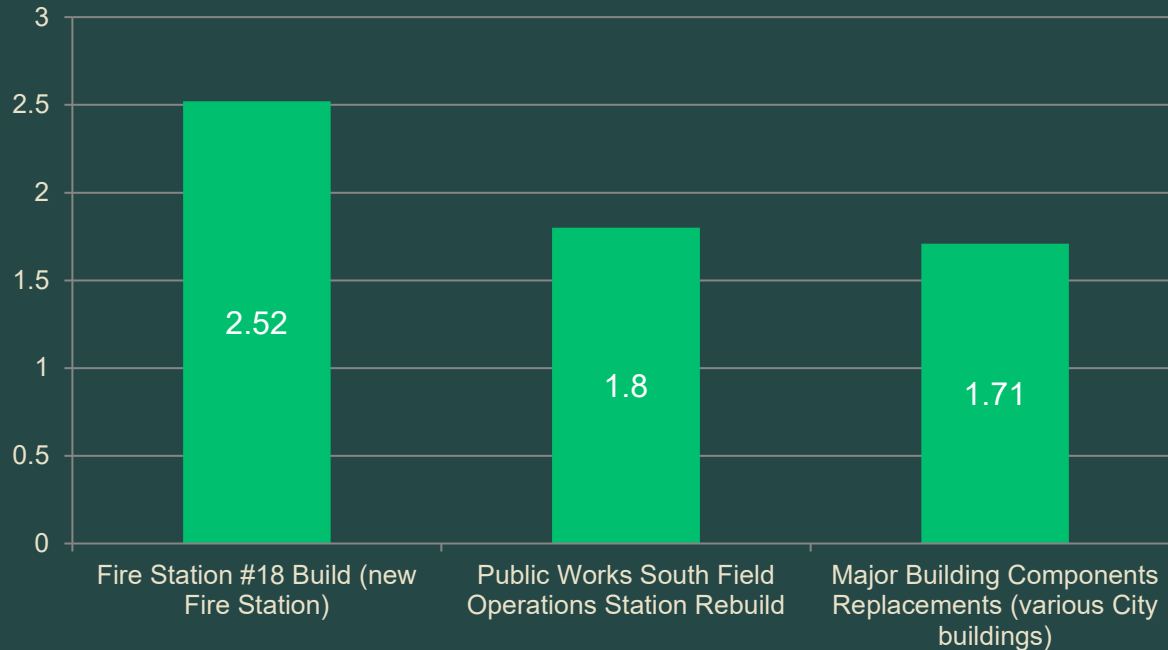
# QUESTION 2: Rank the Proposed Streets Improvements Projects from Highest to Lowest Priority

### PARKS

- Village Creek Trail is a priority
- Desire New Park/splash pad at Leader Overland West
- Kids need improvements, not dogs
- Bowman Springs needs a new playground
- Dunlop Park LL Fields should be added to the project list (7 comments)

### PUBLIC WORKS

- Should roads be widened with increase of impervious surface that will increase flash flooding?
