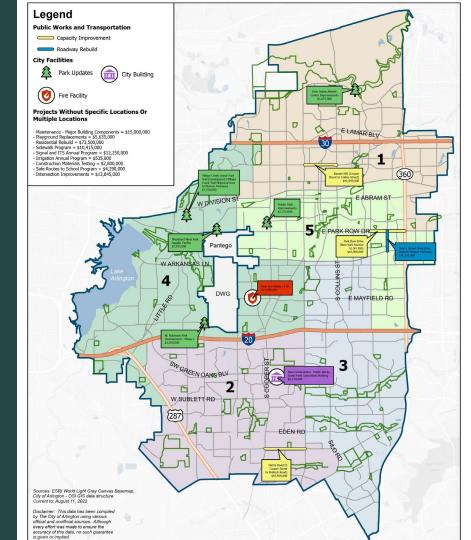

#### OPTION DEVELOPMENT APPROACH

- Stay within capacity limit (\$213,355,000)
- Include as many Top Priority projects as possible
- Include funding for needed Annual Programs (at reduced amounts)
  - Residential Rebuilds
  - Sidewalk Program
  - Irrigation Annual Program
  - Construction Materials Testing
  - Safe Routes to School Program
- Try to balance projects geographically as best as possible
- Consider projects that have been in approved in 2014 and 2018 for overall balance



## POTENTIAL 5<sup>TH</sup> YEAR PROGRAM CONSIDERATIONS

- The CBC has been working on the assumption of a 4-year bond program
- In the past, City Councils have asked to add a 5<sup>th</sup> year to be able to program additional high-priority projects
- In anticipation of a similar request for this Bond Program, the options
  presented include potential recommendations that the Committee
  could submit as a part of the Final Recommendation to the Council
  for consideration
- Treasury estimates approximately \$65 million capacity to be available in FY28

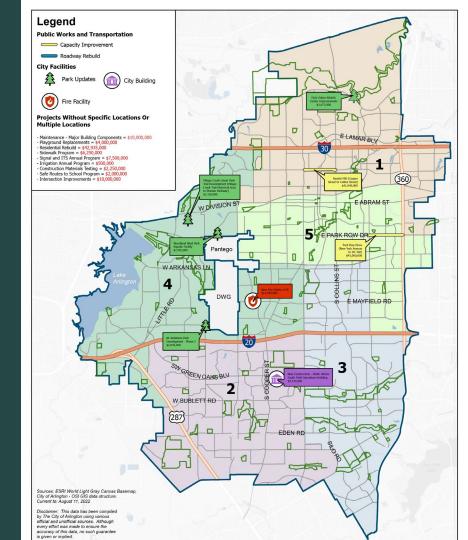

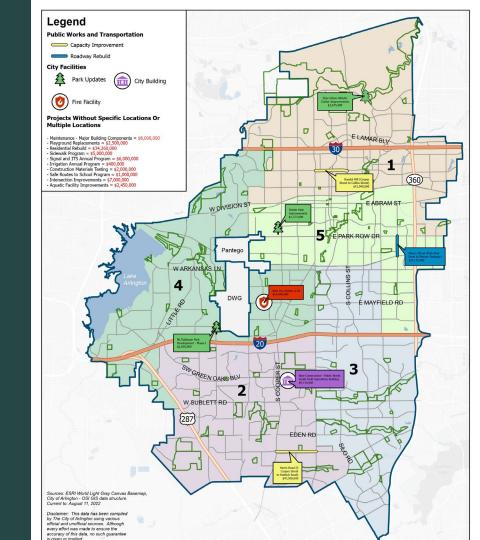

#### **PROS**

- Includes Harris Road
- Aquatic Center project added to have a water component (some improvements would be made at Woodland West Aquatic Center)
- More Projects included (18)

#### CONS

- More significant reduction of scalable projects to fit more projects

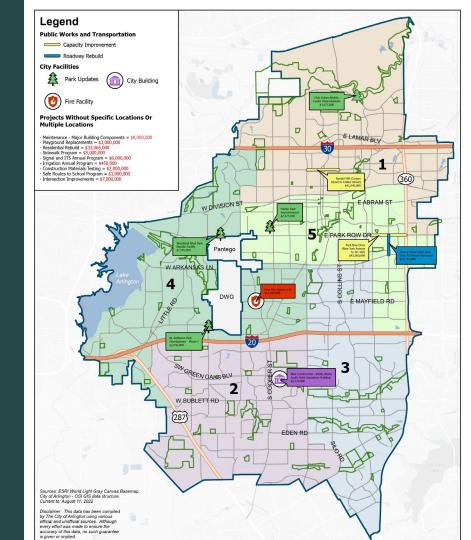
