Registration for Faith & Blue Weekend and National Night Out is Open!

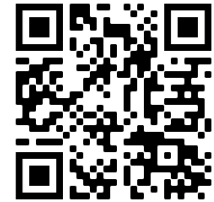
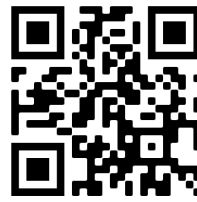

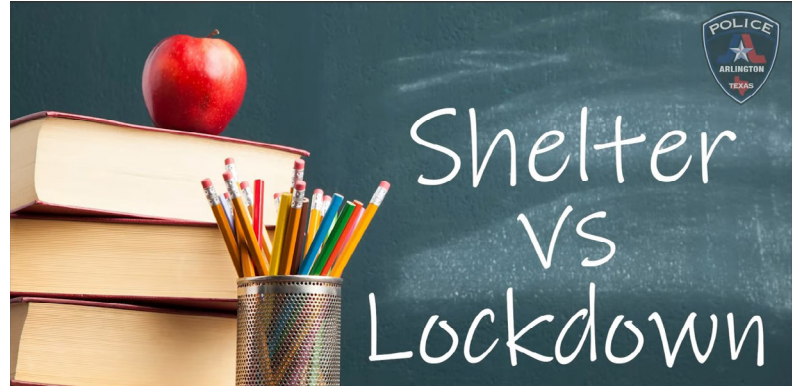
Working Together to Keep Schools Safe

The safety of students, staff, and visitors at schools is a top priority for the Arlington Police Department and their partners at Arlington ISD.

When an emergency happens at or near a school, the public will be informed about what school safety terms mean and where to get critical information.

APD and AISD have worked together to create videos to inform the public about what happens when a school is placed on "Lockdown" or "Shelter" and the importance of properly securing firearms so they're not easily accessible to kids and teens. Links to the videos are below.
